- You must receive your electricity bill from LADWP, SCE, or PWP

How Much Will I Save?

Solar system size and bill savings are based on your current monthly electric bill and your usage over the past 12 months. We also look at how much space is on your roof and other construction factors. Your solar system will be sized to cover up to 75 percent or more of your electric bill.
