Gipson Tapped as Member of Transportation Committee

SACRAMENTO, Calif --- Assemblymember Mike A. Gipson, Chairman of the Assembly Democratic Caucus, was appointed to the Assembly Transportation Committee today by Assembly Speaker Anthony Rendon.

"I am both honored and privileged to serve on this very important committee, and I thank Speaker Rendon for his confidence in me" said Asm. Gipson. "Last year this state legislature passed one of the most robust and historic transportation packages in modern history that invests in our roads, bridges, and creates jobs.
